Sessions will use various platforms such as Cyber Explorers, and TryHackMe which cover a wide range of computing areas such as identifying vulnerabilities, Linux command line and forensics. Students will be preparing for the CyberCenturion competition in the first term along with competing in the three qualifying rounds.

Students will also participate in NCSC (National Cyber Security Centre) and other cyber security based competitions during the course of the academic year.

Sessions will be led by our Head of School (Cyber Security) Mr Jared Cruz who was a winner of CyberCenturion 2017, coached his first team to the Grand Finals in 2021 and has years of industry experience.

He will be supported by our highly experienced and talented industry experts who have been the key to our successes over the years.

All equipment will be provided by The Academy however students are more than welcome to bring their own laptop.

Sessions will cost £5 per student and will be billed in a month' advance.

Spaces will be limited to 20 students who must be in school years 7 - 13.
